

Steve Marsh/Terry Stanton Scholarship Application

The Midland County Amateur Sports Capital Committee (MCASCC) is pleased to announce the establishment of the Steve Marsh/Terry Stanton Scholarship Fund. The Marsh/Stanton Scholarships will be awarded to two Midland County high school senior student-athletes – one male and one female, who have demonstrated excellence in competition, in the classroom, and in the community – and are planning to continue their education beyond high school.

Steve Marsh and Terry Stanton were two long-time Midlanders who made a significant difference in the lives of thousands of young student-athletes. Marsh was the Athletic Director and a football coach at Midland High School for over 20 years, while Stanton was the driving force behind the development of the Midland Soccer Complex. Both men were instrumental leaders of the MASCC since its inception.

The two \$250 scholarships are offered to high school seniors, one male and one female, who have competed in high school athletics for at least two years, including their senior year. The scholarship funds of the recipients will be sent to the post-secondary school where they will be attending.

Minimum requirements include:

- 1) Minimum high school grade point average of 3.0
- 2) Participate in amateur athletics for a minimum of two years, including senior year
- 3) Continuing education after high school graduation

Applicants must submit:

- 1) Completed application form
- 2) High school transcripts
- 3) Brief essay on how your athletic experience has prepared you for your career and educational goals
- 4) Three letters of reference (ie teacher, coach, employer, acquaintance, etc)
